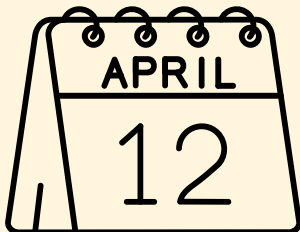
Camp
